REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ADC

(Alcohol Drug Counselor, IC&RC Level Certification)

- 1. Applicant must submit a completed portfolio/application.
- 2. Work Experience: Must have documented 6,000 hours of work experience. A Bachelor's Degree in a human services field may be substituted for 2,000 hours of work experience. A Master's Degree in a human services field may be substituted for 4,000 hours.
- Clinical Supervision: Must have documented a minimum of 300 hours in the four domains. A minimum of 10 hours in each four domains must be documented.
- 4. Education/Training: 300 clock hours of education/training must be documented. This education must be in four domains and be from an accredited college or university. Must include 6 hours of ethics education and 4 hours of AIDS/HIV education. Original transcripts must be sent from the college or university.
- Evaluations: Applicants must have three (3) colleague evaluations and one supervisor evaluation submitted. Must be submitted by the evaluators, not the applicant.
